

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR MEMBERS TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT BOARD

The Construction Industry Development Board (cidb) is a statutory body established in terms of Act No. 38 of 2000 to provide strategic leadership to construction industry stakeholders to stimulate sustainable industry growth, performance, enhanced delivery and transformation within an enabling, regulated environment. The cidb is led by the Board which is appointed by, and reports to, the Minister of Public Works.

The Minister of Public Works, Honourable Geoff Doidge, MP, hereby invites nominations for new members to serve on the fourth Board of the cidb for a period of three years from December 2010. Section 6 of the cidb Act stipulates that members of the Board must be persons with leadership qualities and must have the ability to contribute to the strategic direction of the cidb in the interest of Construction Industry development. Any nominated person must be a citizen of, and ordinarily resident in, the Republic of South Africa.

Board members are expected to possess knowledge and expertise relating to Board responsibilities, including fiduciary duties, and any of the following construction industry-related areas: construction, black economic empowerment and the emerging sector, labour/industrial relations, built environment professions, education, training and development, research and development, project financing, construction procurement, public and private sector clients of the industry, and other areas.

Nominations must be in writing and must contain the following basic information:

- Name, address and telephone number(s) of the nominating person or organisation
- Name, identity number, address and telephone number(s) of the nominee
- A declaration by the nominee that he/she is qualified to serve on this Board in terms of section 6 of the cidb Act, (Act 38 of 2000)
- A motivation for the appointment of the nominee to the cidb (Max. 1 page)
- A short Curriculum Vitae of the nominee (Max. 2 pages)

In constituting the Construction Industry Development Board, the Minister will take due cognizance of the need to achieve a balance of expertise and knowledge of the construction industry, whilst broadly reflecting the race, gender and geographic composition of the Republic of South Africa.

About the cidb:

Among the key programmes and instruments of the cidb are the Register of Contractors, which categorises and grades contractors according to capability to carry out construction projects; the Standard for Uniformity in Construction Procurement, aimed at streamlining construction procurement in the public sector; the Register of Projects, which reflects the size, nature and distribution of construction projects; the National Contractor Development Programme, which sets out the framework for enterprise development; and the cidb construction industry performance status reports.

The closing date for nominations is 09 December 2010.
